FLU VACCINATIONS – 13 11 2024 **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

Please be aware that flu vaccinations will be taking place in school on Wednesday 13th November 2024. Please read the information below that we have received from the immunisation team.

If you would like your child to receive the vaccination you MUST complete the online consent form via the link in the letter.

As you will read below there is no guarantee that forms submitted after this date will be accepted.

We are looking forward to visiting your school on: 13/11/2024 for the annual flu immunisation session for your school.

Please could the below letter, containing a secure link to complete the consent form, be sent out to parents. The deadline for parents to complete is 11/11/2024. We cannot guarantee any forms submitted after this date and time will be accepted at the school session.

Your child's Annual Flu Vaccination Is Now Due, please click the below link to complete a consent form.

This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of flu.

Most children are offered a nasal spray vaccine which is a quick, simple and painless spray up the nose.

The nasal spray vaccine is the most effective vaccine. The nasal spray vaccine contains a very small amount of porcine gelatine as an essential ingredient to keep it stable and able to work. For those who may not accept medicines or vaccines that contain porcine gelatine, a flu vaccine injection is available. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, the type of flu can vary each winter, so it is recommended to have it again this year or they won't be protected.

Since the programme was introduced, most children offered the vaccine in schools have had the immunisation.
