I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to you to share some exciting news regarding the Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education curriculum that we will be implementing in the upcoming academic year. After careful consideration, we have decided to introduce the Ten:Ten Life to the Full Plus scheme, which is specifically designed for Catholic schools across the UK. This replaces our existing programme, Journey In Love.

The Ten:Ten curriculum offers a fully resourced spiral approach to learning, which allows our pupils to build upon their knowledge as they progress through the different phases of education. This scheme will be organised as follows:

Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

Key Stage 1 (KS1)

Lower Key Stage 2 (LKS2)

Upper Key Stage 2 (UKS2)

Each phase is structured into three comprehensive modules:

- **Created and Loved by God:** This includes units on Religious Understanding, Me, My Body, My Health, Emotional Well-Being, and Life Cycles.
- **Created to Love Others:** This module covers Religious Understanding, Personal Relationships, Life Online, and Keeping Safe.
- **Created to Live in Community:** This final module also incorporates Religious Understanding and focuses on Living in the Wider World.

Each unit is equipped with fully resourced sessions, inclusive of session notes, presentations, and activities designed for your children's engagement and learning.
